

If you wish to play in a more "competitive" format between multiple teams, you can choose to do so! Our games don't automatically keep track of completion time. Thus, we suggest that one person per group take a photo or a screenshot of the final page indicating success and send it to your event organizer.

You can also use the point system shown below in order to create a score for each team. It consists of a grid that can be used to figure out how many points are earned by each time depending on their speed and autonomy for each of the game's steps. It is important to assign one person per team that will make sure that scores are calculated every step of the way!

At the end, you can add up all of those points to get your final score and compare it with the other teams' to find out who won the competition!
